I am pleased to present this application form for the Inter-Provincial Tournament in Winnipeg next summer. It's a great opportunity to meet other players from across the country, or reunite with former opponents from past IPs, and especially, to **bring home the gold for Ontario**.

Ontario is permitted to send two ladies' teams of four, two men's teams of four, and one lady and one man as substitutes. This means nine ladies and nine men will be selected.

Application forms will be reviewed and evaluated by a committee. Scores will be tallied so that the average score from the independent reviewers will be used to determine an overall average score. Scores will be weighted most heavily towards skill (70%). The remaining 30% will take OSA tournament participation, previous IP experience, and special circumstances into account.

It is imperative you complete the form to the best of your ability. It is the only thing the selection committee has to accurately give you a score. Assume the committee does not know how you did in Florida or Texas or wherever last year (or Ontario for that matter).

Please review the attached paperwork from the CNSA regarding costs, rules, a release to be signed by those qualifying to play, covid policies, and other important information. Forward all questions to me and I'll get the answer.

Ignore the dates stated on the CNSA paperwork with respect to application and payment deadlines. Applications must be received by me on or before January 31 to be accepted for consideration. Immediately after being selected, applicants will be instructed on sending in the release form and payment to the OSA. We hope to have everything decided before February 15.

The CNSA strongly encourages all players and non-players to purchase “Out-of-Province” insurance.

Inter Provincial deadline for team registration: **February 15, 2023**

Cancellation requests received prior to March 15, 2023 fully refunded; between March 16 and March 31, 50% refunded; after April 1, 2023 no refund. In the event of tournament cancellation due to COVID, etc. 90% refund till May 1st, 2023.

Players fees cover the cost of rental and use of the “Pembina Curling Club” and facilities, five coffee breaks/snacks, five lunches, “Meet and Greet” event with appetizers and the Awards “Happy Hour” and Banquet

Players are expected to wear uniforms representing their province, bring provincial memorabilia (pins or the like) to exchange with other players and wear **closed-toe** shoes during play.

Due to Covid and/or related variants as well as general health or injury concerns, the CNSA is providing the **option** for each province to add one male and one female player, **from their province**, to their roster as a designated substitute. These players must register as a “Non-Player” and pay the appropriate fee.

Your roster should include a maximum of 2 men's teams and 2 women's teams (per province) with four players per team. One additional woman and/or man **from your province** may be added to the roster as designated substitutes.

The CNSA follows **ISA** rules. The specific rules relative to substitutes, are listed in the **ISA RULES 1.3.12.1**. **Please note: As per ISA Rule 1.3.12.1.2. The substitute must be named by the Team Captain or the National President and the Tournament Director informed prior to the start of the tournament.**
